NEW DIVE BOAT AT AQUANAUTS GRENADA

The third dive boat "SALSA", a 39 foot "Seahawk" arrived in Grenada to serve groups up to 20 divers and provide pleasant rides to famous dive sites like Bianca C, San Juan and unspoiled "Isle de Rhonde" offshore islands.

Grenada, March 1. 2004: **Aquanauts Grenada proudly announces the arrival of their third dive boat; "SALSA". The new US-build Sea Hawk dive master vessel with a Yanmar 370 hp engine features all amenities and safety features, customers of Aquanauts Grenada have come to expect; fresh water shower, large platform, convenient ladder, cabin with shade, marine head, dry storage, camera table, camera rinse tank, GPS, VHF, fly bridge, dry storage and a water tight deck.**

The 39 foot boat gives ample space for 20 divers and their gear. Its fast engine setup brings divers within minutes to dive sites around the south west coast of Grenada and only takes one hour to the virgin dive sites of "Isle de Rhonde" offshore islands.

Passengers enjoy the ride protected from spray by the cabin, which makes it the perfect vessel to explore the more challenging dive sites out in the Atlantic. Together with the reliable service of her sister boats "CALYPSO" and "SOCA" it gives Aquanauts the ability to serve guest more individually and avoid crowds; assigning groups on three boats according to their experience level.
