Sea Space Symposium visits Grenada's Underwater Sites.

Astronauts Buzz Aldrin and Guion Bluford enjoyed Grenada's diving during the latest Sea Space Symposium

Grenada, May 2008: Famous moon walker Buzz Aldrin "set foot" on Grenada's Bianca C wreck, 39 years after he and Neil Armstrong walked on the moon. Mr. Aldrin together with fellow astronaut Guion Blueford; directors of NOAA and Boeing, Researchers and Explorers such as Ian Koblick – the founder of Underwater Lodge stayed at the True Blue Bay Resort for the annual "Sea Space Symposium" meeting.

The group was founded in 1970 by prominent figures in government, industry, science, underwater- and space exploration and remains dedicated to the advancement of scientific and technological developments in space and the sea. The group chooses scuba diving as a recreational activity, where the underwater experiences are creating a stimulating environment for their work. In Grenada they visited several dive sites, including the legendary wreck of the cruise ship Bianca C, the wreck of the freighter "Shakem and Shark reef. The latter was especially well received, with its bounty of marine life from crabs and nurse sharks to turtles and schools of fish; Shark reef was so enjoyable the group opted to dive it twice.

Mark Ward, president of Sci Tek Communications and organizer of the trip said: *".. nothing could compare to the fun we had diving with you! Everyone had a great time and I heard a lot of nice comments about how professional the dive operation was."*

After the meetings at True Blue Bay conference room, the group relaxed at the Dodgy Dock Bar, enjoyed local cuisine at Aquarium and True Blue Restaurant. Kennedy Tours was pleased to show the group Grenada's beauty above the surface and the great history of the isle of spice. Grenada's Minister for Tourism Mrs. Clarice Modeste-Curwen also met the group at a formal dinner at the True Blue Restaurant.
